• To develop a safe and innovative process that leads to the successful identification and recruitment of potential football players, within the local area.


- Provide a platform for those entering the program to gain confidence, flourish and develop. Hopefully over time, becoming a representative and guide them to further success!

Total Football Academy Code of Conduct for Parents

At Total Football Academy, we are committed to fostering a positive and supportive environment for all players, coaches, and families. As parents, your role is vital in creating an atmosphere where players can develop, thrive, and enjoy the game. The following Code of Conduct outlines expectations for parents to ensure football remains a positive experience for everyone.

Respect for Players

- Encourage your child to play for enjoyment and self-improvement, and thrive to be succesfull.
- Support all players on the team, recognizing that effort and learning are more important than immediate success.
- 3. Avoid coaching from the sidelines. Allow the coach to guide the team.

Respect for Coaches and Officials

- Respect the decisions made by coaches, understanding they have the best interests of the team in mind.
- Refrain from criticizing referees or officials. Accept that mistakes are part of the game.
- Address concerns constructively and privately with the coach or team management, not during or immediately after games.

Respect for the Game

- Promote good sportsmanship by applauding effort, teamwork, and fair play by all teams.
- Avoid negative behavior such as yelling, swearing, or making disparaging remarks about players, coaches, or officials.
- 9. Teach your child the value of respect for opponents and the rules of the game.

Safety and Well-being

- Ensure your child arrives on time, prepared, and equipped for games and training sessions.
- Promote a healthy lifestyle by supporting proper nutrition, hydration, and adequate rest for your child.
- 12. Encourage your child to speak up if they feel unwell or unsafe.

Positive Support

- 13. Be a positive role model by displaying calm, supportive, and enthusiastic behavior.
- 14. Celebrate the effort and progress of all players, not just your child.
- 15. Encourage your child to accept feedback and learn from setbacks.

Parents who violate this Code of Conduct may face disciplinary actions, including:
